Particularly, this was described as the first attempt of bringing the teachers in rural area together in this issue.

4. SPECIAL GUIDANCE THROUGH INVENTORY CLASSES TO RURAL STUDENTS

Due to an unfortunate but a certain fear in the minds of students of the 9th and 10th standards, the number of failures particularly in the subjects of Mathematics, English language and Science. is considerably worriably more. Considering this, the SKS Pratishtan took a lead to arrange a series of inventory classes by eminent teachers working in various renowned educational institutes, for these subjects. The first of such a kind of class was arranged in the home village, Pangaon, on dt. 14.07.2018. In the Saraswati School of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education at Pangaon, 160 students of the class 9th and 10th attended this special coaching by eminent and expert teachers from Latur and Ambajogai. The experts were, Mr. M. K. Kabade (Professor in Physics), Mr. Shridhar Nagargoje (Expert in English at DIET) and Mr. Kasture (Expert in Mathematics). The students were happy and satisfied with the inspirational and interesting teaching given by these experts. The function was inaugurated by the Chairman of Local Body (Gram Panchayat) Mr. Sukesh Bhandare, in presence of the Executive Members of the SKS Pratishtan. A good quality Dictionary was presented to the students, as Educational Aid.

5. MEDICAL AWARENESS CAMP FOR THE ADOLESCENT GIRLS AND THEIR MOTHERS

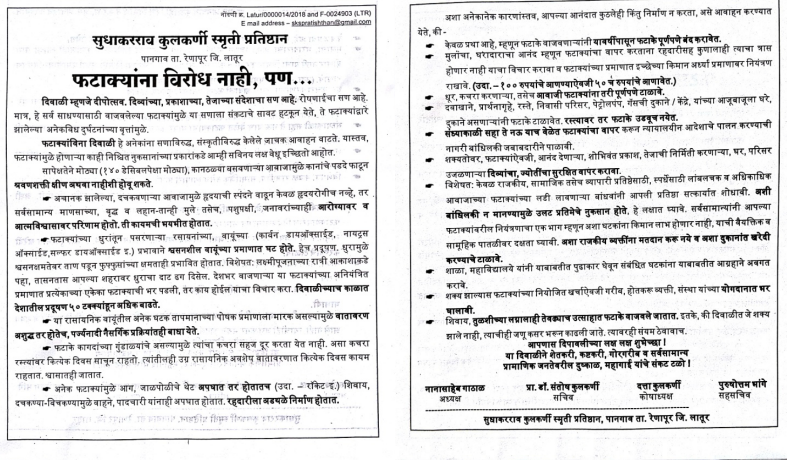

Its sensitive that, simple natural physiological process of menstruation, produces a hindrance in education of the adolescent girl students. Particularly in rural areas, the fear, consciousness, discomfort, hesitations are aggrieved by lack of knowledge and awareness. The problem of handling so routine and natural process is taken in a very naïve manner, frequently forcing them to compromise over consistency in daily school activities, studies, regularity and concentration. This brings a weakness and inferiority complex to the girl students. This fact came before the forum of discussion during the first convention of teachers in rural areas. The Trust has sincerely thought and inadvertently put itself into an action plan to work on this issue. A series of medical awareness programmes over this issue has been planned. The first one was arranged in Saraswati Vidyalaya at Pangaon. However, the Chairman of the Manav Vikas Sanstha came forward to help for organizing it for the girls in all the schools in Pangaon. This resulted in an organized meet of about 400 girl students, alongwith their parents, folk women, women - social workers. Dr. Sunita Patil, Dr. Jayashree Hujare, Dr. Rajani Chavan and the social worker teacher Mulla Ruksana Mainoddin were the main speakers.

6. AWARENESS AGAINST UNRULY USE OF CRACKERS DURING THE FESTIVALS

Despite consistent and insistent efforts by the government and NGOs, it becomes unavoidable to generate and re-generate awareness against the use of crackers during festivals, especially, Diwali. Also, despite the hard realities of many unforeseen and unfortunate incidents, the socio-economic irrelevance and issues of pollution, certain social issues are raised and the exaggerated use of crackers becomes a venture of false values. The Trust cannot keep itself away from its duty to contribute in the efforts of generating awareness among the folk. A reasonable draft therefore was prepared and distributed among the folk, in the form of 10000 hand bills.



7. OPENING OF MARATHI VIDNYAN PARISHAD CHAPTER IN PANGAON

Marathi Vidnyan Parishad is statewide activity aided by the State Government and is working for generation of information and awareness of science in regional language Marathi. It runs its chapters, concentrating aims and objectives to spread scientific information and know-hows among schools, colleges and folk. It especially, appreciates work in rural area, for the potential and scope of the scientific ideas and awareness. The Trust showed its interest to participate in this work and formed a separate activity under its banner, with special approval. The Head Office, despite its no agenda, has approved a chapter in Pangaon, as a special case. The separate section of Marathi Vidnyan Parishad is now sanctioned. It will take its shape through its relentless and consistent activities.



8. EDUCATION MATERIAL TO SCHOOLS

The schools are always in need of good reading material for improvement and suggestions on innovations. Such a kind of reading material was found to be compiled in a Diwali Special Issue of daily 'UDYACHA MARATHWADA', including the articles of eminent educationists, office bearers and former as well as working education ministers. The material if made available to teachers, may inculcate better passion and modus of imparting education in rural area. Hence, 10 schools in rural area were gifted with issues of this important reading material, based on education and education methods.

9. INSTALLATION OF SANITARY PAD VENDING MACHINE IN SCHOOL

In continuation and persuasion with the medical awareness campaign, a more constructive need based activity was carried out, in order to concentrate on the issues of health among the girl students and their mother parents. On occasion of Savitribai Phule Jayanthi, a semi automatic Sanitary Pad Vending Machine was installed in donation, at Tirupati Vidyalaya, Pangaon. The importance, mode of use and maintenance were explained to the students. The Head Master, staff and students enthusiastically welcomed and appreciated this venture of the Turst. Apart from this, a group of voluntary students was also formed to monitor the use and maintenance of the machine.

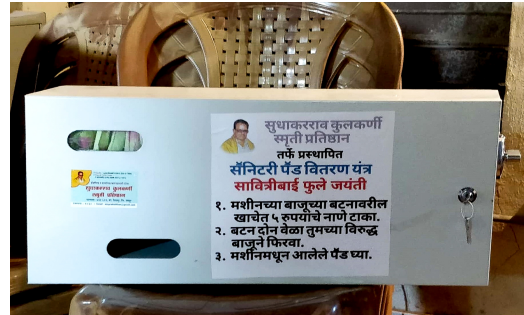

10. SURVEY OF MEDICAL PREDICAMENTS AMONG THE ADOLESCENT GIRL STUDENTS IN RURAL AREA

In persuasion of the medical predicaments, particularly, menstruation and allied processes, it has been observed, that there is still need to look into the problem through many windows. One such window can be opened by making the girls express themselves. A thoughtful, crisp questionnaire was drafted and it is being circulated through schools in rural area. So far we have been able to circulate it among 500 students in five schools and there is a good response to it. A target to reach to about 1 lakh girls is set for the next year, through this survey. It is speculated that, this will generate good baseline data to establish indicators of rural women health in adolescence and will be helpful in designing further need based action plan.

11. MEDICAL AWARENESS CAMP FOR THE ADOLESCENT GIRLS AND THEIR MOTHERS AT UJANI TQ. AMBAJOGAI DIST. BEED



The Trust has sincerely thought and inadvertently put itself into an action plan to work on the issue of abstinence of education in rural girl students due to particularly the inevitable menstruation and allied health problems. A series of medical awareness programmes over this issue has been planned. The first one was arranged in Saraswati Vidyalaya at Pangaon on the 23rd of October, 2018, followed by installation of Sanitary Pad Vedning Machine on 3rd of January, 2019, in commemoration of Late Savitribai Phule, the pioneer lady activist for initiative in Women Education in Maharashtra. It was seconded by the awareness programme at a village Ujani, in Siddheshwar Vidyalaya, at a village Ujani, (Tehsil Ambajogai, Dist. Beed) on 10th January, 2019. Parents, folk women, women social workers were also present.. Dr. Sunita Patil, and the social worker teacher Mulla Ruksana Mainoddin were the main speakers. Dr. Swapnali Swami of the Primary Health Centre and the lady member of Executive Body of Pratishthan Sow. Vrushali Kulkarni were also present alongwith the lade teacher staff of the school. More than 125 girl students were

present for this programme and they had an interactive session with the medical officers at this moment.


