

11. MEDICAL AWARENESS CAMP FOR THE ADOLESCENT GIRLS AND THEIR MOTHERS AT UJANI TQ. AMBAJOGAI DIST. BEED



The Trust has sincerely thought and inadvertently put itself into an action plan to work on the issue of abstinence of education in rural girl students due to particularly the inevitable menstruation and allied health problems. A series of medical awareness programmes over this issue has been planned. The first one was arranged in Saraswati Vidyalaya at Pangaon on the 23rd of October, 2018, followed by installation of Sanitary Pad Vending Machine on 3rd of January, 2019, in commemoration of Late Savitribai Phule, the pioneer lady activist for initiative in Women Education in Maharashtra. It was seconded by the awareness programme at a village Ujani, in Siddheshwar Vidyalaya, at a village Ujani, (Tehsil Ambajogai, Dist. Beed) on 10th January, 2019. Parents, folk women, women social workers were also present.. Dr. Sunita Patil, and the social worker teacher Mulla Ruksana Mainoddin were the main speakers. Dr. Swapnali Swami of the Primary Health Centre and the lady member of Executive Body of Pratishthan Sow. Vrushali Kulkarni were also present alongwith the lade teacher staff of the school. More than 125 girl students were present for this programme and they had an interactive session with the medical officers at this moment.
